



## CBS Democratic Presidential Debate To Be Simulcast Live On C-SPAN Radio

*(FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, Nov. 12, 2015)* -- CBS News has given C-SPAN Radio permission to air the 2<sup>nd</sup> Democratic presidential candidate debate LIVE, beginning at 9 pm ET on Saturday, Nov. 14.

The Saturday night debate, featuring Hillary Clinton, Bernie Sanders and Martin O'Malley, is being hosted by CBS News in partnership with Twitter, KCCI-TV and the Des Moines Register, from Drake University in Des Moines.

CBS News is also allowing C-SPAN to re-air the debate in its entirety on Sunday, Nov. 15, at 4pmET and 9pmET.

"C-SPAN thanks CBS News for allowing our viewers and listeners to catch this second presidential debate," said C-SPAN political editor Steve Scully. "The debates are very important and CBS News is providing an even wider audience the ability to watch on TV and listen on radio."
